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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

You must be a current financial member of Blacktown Workers Club Limited (Club) to be eligible to book an event at any of the function and conference facilities located at any premises of the Club (Event). A membership number will be required to be provided to the Club upon booking the Event.

1. MINIMUM NUMBERS

- 1.1 All event packages are priced on a minimum of 50 guests. If an event package for less than fifty (50) guests is required, additional charges may apply.

2. TENTATIVE BOOKING

- 2.1 A tentative booking may be placed at the absolute discretion of the Club and such a booking will be held by the Club for a maximum period of fourteen (14) days (Tentative Booking Period).
- 2.2 If, upon the expiry of the Temporary Booking Period, a deposit in accordance with our Terms and Conditions has not been paid to the Club, the Club may cancel the tentative booking. For the avoidance of doubt, upon cancellation of a tentative booking by the Club, any facilities booked in relation to the tentative booking will be available for booking by any other party.

3. CONFIRMATION OF BOOKING

- 3.1 A deposit of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) or fifteen percent (15%) of the Total Event Charge, whichever is the greater, is payable upon confirmation of a booking (Deposit). The Total Event Charge includes all food, beverage, equipment hire costs, and other costs associated with the Event.
- 3.2 Written confirmation of the tentative booking, and a signed copy of our Terms and Conditions must be received by the Club within the Tentative Booking Period in order to confirm and secure an event booking at the Club.

4. ROOM HIRE

- 4.1 Room hire charges are included in the event package prices for all events with over fifty (50) guests in attendance. If an event has less than fifty (50) guests in attendance, room hire fees will be charged to the Event Organiser.

5. SMOKING

- 5.1 All function rooms are non-smoking. Designated smoking areas have been allocated within the Club for your guests' convenience.

6. MENU SELECTION

- 6.1 Final menu selection is required two (2) weeks prior to the Event. Any special meals, including those relating to specific dietary or medical requirements, must also be identified and advised to the Club at this time.
- 6.2 Some items can be subject to change without notice.

7. FINAL NUMBERS

- 7.1 Final numbers of guests in attendance at the Event (Final Numbers) must be provided to the Club no less than seven (7) days prior to the Event. Charges will be based on the Final Numbers supplied to the Club or the actual number of guests in attendance at the Event, whichever is the greater. If the Final Numbers provided to the Club is less than twenty percent (20%) or more from the original quoted number of guests, additional charges may apply.

8. CANCELLATION

- 8.1 If you cancel the Event with more than sixty (60) days notice prior to the Event Date, any Deposit paid will be refunded.
- 8.2 The following cancellation fees apply if you cancel the Event:
- 8.2.1 Between thirty (30) and sixty (60) days notice prior to the Event Date – The deposit paid will be forfeited and you will be required to pay an additional ten percent (10%) of the estimated Total Event Charge;
- 8.2.2 Between seven (7) and thirty (30) days notice prior to the Event Date – The deposit paid will be forfeited and you will be required to pay an additional fifteen percent (15%) of the estimated Total Event Charge; and
- 8.2.3 Less than seven (7) days notice prior to the Event Date – The Deposit paid will be forfeited and you will be required to pay the remaining total balance of estimated Total Event Charge.
- 8.3 All cancellations must be made in writing and delivered to the other party.

9. SURCHARGES

- 9.1 A fifteen percent (15%) surcharge on the Total Event Charge will apply to Events commencing on Public Holidays and ten percent (10%) for Sundays will be payable by you.

10. FINAL PAYMENT

- 10.1 Final payment of the Event must be made seven (7) days prior to the Event Date with any additional charges being settled at the conclusion of the function. Account facilities may be arranged with the Club and are subject to credit application approval. All credit accounts must be paid in full within seven (7) days of the receipt of the invoice from the Club.

11. BLACKTOWN WORKERS CLUB SIGN-IN POLICY

- 11.1 All guests attending an event at the Club are required to comply with the sign-in requirements prescribed from time to time by the Registered Clubs Act 1976 (NSW) or any other State or Federal Legislation. Guests are advised to produce identification as proof of address upon entering the Club.

12. CONDUCT OF THE EVENT

- 12.1 Unless otherwise agreed by the Club, the Event must finish at the time specified on the initial booking. The Event must be conducted in accordance with all State and Federal Legislation, applicable safety standards, and any sound curfews imposed by the Local Council.
- 12.2 The Club reserves the right to end the Event if the club reasonably believes that the Event may affect the operation of the Club's business, security, reputation, or that the Event is not being conducted in a lawful manner.
- 12.3 The Club has no responsibility to you for any costs, damages or expenses that you may incur in relation to the Club's termination of the event under this clause.
- 12.4 Smoke machines, special balloon effects and/or pyrotechnics must not be used without the prior approval of the Club.

13. ADDITIONAL FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- 13.1 No additional food from outside the Club is to be brought on to the Club premises without the prior approval of the Club nor can food or beverages be taken off the premises during or at completion of the Event.
- 13.2 Alcoholic or other Beverages are not permitted to be brought onto the premises from outside as we are a licensed venue and all alcoholic drinks consumed on the premises must be purchased on the premises, nor can any gifts or prizes containing alcoholic or other beverages be brought onto the premises.
Special event cakes i.e. Birthdays, Engagements are permitted, and Function Office must be notified at time of booking.

14. AUDIO VISUAL

- 14.1 Should you require the use of any specialty Audio Visual equipment, an Audio Visual technician must be engaged at the Event and additional charges will apply.

15. SECURITY

- 15.1 For the protection of guests, security guards may be required for the duration of the Event under the advice of the Functions Manager, and at the discretion of the Club. You agree to pay the cost of the security guard if advised by the Functions Manager that such guard is required. Notice of such requirement will be provided to you at the time of booking.

16. MINORS

- 16.1 You agree to comply with the Registered Clubs Act in regards to persons under the age of eighteen (18) years on licensed premises.

17. DIRECTIONS FROM THE CLUB

- 17.1 You agree to comply with any reasonable direction given to you by the senior employee of the Club or his or her delegate then on duty.

18. RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

18.1 In accordance with the Club’s Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy, the Club reserves the right to refuse supply of alcohol and to require any or all guests to leave the premises if, in the opinion of any employee or security guard, that guest or those guests appear to have engaged in the excessive consumption of alcohol.

19. FORCE MAJEURE

19.1 The Club is not responsible for any costs, damages or expenses that you may suffer or incur if the Club is unable to provide the facilities or any other arrangements for the event or any part of it due to circumstances beyond the Club’s control, including an act of God, general strike, industrial dispute, acts of public enemies, acts of terrorism, riots, civil commotion, malicious damage, sabotage, declaration of war, blockage, disturbance, lightning, fire, earthquake, storm, flood, explosion, governmental or semi-government restraint, expropriation, prohibition, intervention, direction, embargo, power, water or utility shortage and any other cause which is not reasonably within the Club’s control.

20. NO RESPONSIBILITY

20.1 The Club is not responsible for:

- The theft, damage or loss of any goods brought into the Club; or
- Any introduction of food to the Event and the effect of it afterwards.

21. INDEMNITY

21.1 You are responsible for and must indemnify the Club for:

- Any breakages, loss, damage, defacing of property belonging to the Club, arising out of your use, or any person attending the Event. The Club may deduct any amount from the deposit (including the whole deposit) for this purpose;
- Any additional cleaning requirements which the Club considers to be over and above normal cleaning; and
- Any claim, liability or loss in respect of personal injury or the death of any person or loss of or damage to any property (including property of the Club) arising out of or in connection with the Event to the extent permissible by Law.
